_ Warranty


- This luminaire is covered by a 5 year warranty. The warranty is from date of purchase, not the date of installation. Please retain proof of purchase.

Important: Please Read Before Installation


- INSTRUCTIONS PERTAINING TO A RISK OF FIRE, OR INJURY TO PERSONS Lighted lamp is HOT! WARNING To reduce the risk of FIRE OR INJURY TO PERSONS.
 - 1. Turn off/unplug and allow to cool before replacing lamp.
 - 2. Lamp gets HOT quickly! Contact only switch/plug when turning on.
 - 3. Do not touch the hot lens, guard or enclosure.
 - 4. Keep lamp away from materials that may burn.
 - 5. Do not touch lamp at any time. Use a soft cloth. Oil from skin may damage lamp.
 - 6. Do not operate the luminaire fitting with a missing or damaged shield.

Unscrew fixture with the matched tool until the glass removable.



Insert the lamp with the correct wattage and type marked on the fixture label.


CAUTION: Do not exceed maximum wattage marked on luminaire label.

NOTE: DO NOT touch lamp with bare hands. Use soft cloth to handle lamp.


Installation Instructions



3 Install Glass 4 Install Stake




Turn screw with the matched tool until the glass was fixed.



Determine the desired location for mounting the luminaire. Hammer the stake into the ground until flange of stake is flush to grade. To avoid damage to the stake, place a board on top of the stake while hammering.


NOTE:If the ground is hard and the stake is difficult to install, make a crosscut in the ground using a flat shovel.

5 Install Luminaire to Stake



Clear away an area in the ground at the wireway slot on top of the stake. Lay the luminaire pigtail into the wireway slot and screw the stem onto the stake. If the fixture does not look straight, adjust by pushing or pulling on the stake only.

6 Wire Connections



Strip both leads from the luminaire pigtail.
Using two wire connectors (sold separately), connect the leads from the luminaire to the main low voltage supply cable leads.

Install/Replace Bulb

Loosen the lock screw to remove the glare guard. Then remove the inner shield to expose the bulb. Replace it with the correct wattage and type marked on the fixture label. Then reinstall the inner shield and glare guard. IMPORTANT: Halogen bulbs must be protected from moisture and dust at all times. Always reinstall shield when removed.
